Guest Talk (By Prof. BVR Chowdari, NTU, Singapore)

It was our pleasure to have Prof. BVR Chowdari, Senior Executive Director, President's Office, Nanyang Technological University (NTU), Singapore, at IISER Bhopal campus on 22nd November 2016. Prof. BVR Chowdari is actively leading the effort to foster the research collaborations between the Nanyang Technological University of Singapore and the Indian Universities and Institutes of Higher Learning. To facilitate the interaction between IISER Bhopal and NTU, the office of Alumni and International Relations, IISER Bhopal organized a meeting with selected officials which followed by interaction with faculty and students.

The Deans of administrative offices such as Academic Affairs, Faculty Affairs, R & D, Alumni and International Relations presented an overview of their respective offices.

Prof. BVR Chowdari presented a talk where he mentioned about the developmental aspects of NTU (Total Strength and Infrastructure), and various initiatives of NTU which is fostering the university to become a "Fast Rising University". He showed keen interest in developing an association with IISER Bhopal. These presentations set the stage for fruitful discussions which ensued between NTU and IISER Bhopal and are likely to open new opportunities for collaborations between IISER Bhopal and NTU.

Following the meeting, Prof. BVR Chowdari addressed the students and faculty in two interactive sessions and presented a talk on "NTU's Approach to Academic and Research Excellence". He briefed the students about the scope of research within NTU and about various collaborations that NTU has across the globe and he further explained about the research scholarships that exist within NTU.

It was an enlightening session for the students and faculty, as he discussed about the NTU – India Connect which is a platform to explore various opportunities like Student Exchange, Joint Symposia and Research Collaborations between NTU and IISER Bhopal.
